Public Safety Center in Greenspoint**

Greenspoint Community Partners (GCP) recently recognized its partners in the community for their support during 2006. The recognition was part of the “*Greenspoint Partners – A Celebration*” reception, hosted by the Greater Greenspoint District, that acknowledges community leaders for their contributions to Greenspoint programs and initiatives.

“No one organization can care for *all* the needs in a community,” said Shelia Redmon-Jones, GCP’s executive director. “Partnerships are the key to a vibrant neighborhood. It’s important that we acknowledge those who are volunteering their time, talent or financial support to benefit all of us by keeping services available in Greenspoint,” she added.

Greenspoint Mall, American Bureau of Shipping and Parkway Properties were recognized for their support of the Greenspoint Public Safety Center, located at Greenspoint Mall. “Without Greenspoint Mall’s donation of space, we might not have a police station in the heart of this community,” said Jerry Lowry, GCP’s board chairman. He continues, “The rent for that space is valued at more than \$100,000 a year. Generous contributions, like that of Greenspoint Mall, allow us to focus funds raised directly toward programs that make the community safe.”

Transwestern Commercial Services showed its support for Greenspoint’s parks by making a donation toward youth recreation programs at Wussow Park. In addition, Caldwell Watson Real Estate Group’s, Bill Ginder, and his wife Margaret, along with Greater Greenspoint Redevelopment Authority executive director, Sally Bradford, were recognized for their contributions to GCP programs.
